From harbour ferries to beach buses, Sydney's transport makes exploring this stunning city a breeze. Grab your Opal card and get ready for some of the world's most scenic commutes.



MAIN TRANSPORT OPTIONS



Trains

Sydney Trains operates extensive rail network across Greater Sydney with 8 lines serving 178 stations.

- Daily: 4:00 AM - 1:00 AM (limited night services)
- Airport Line connects to Kingsford Smith Airport
- Blue Mountains Line for scenic day trips
- Express services available on most lines

Pro Tip: Take the T4 Eastern Suburbs Line for stunning harbour views between Martin Place and Bondi Junction!



Light Rail

Modern tram system with L1 Dulwich Hill Line and L2/L3 CBD and South East Light Rail.

- Daily: 5:00 AM - 1:00 AM
- Connects Central Station to key destinations
- L1: Inner West to Dulwich Hill
- L2/L3: CBD to Randwick and Kingsford

Pro Tip: The light rail offers great city views and connects major shopping and entertainment precincts!



PASSES & TICKETS



Opal Card

Reloadable smart card for all Sydney public transport

- Works on trains, buses, light rail, ferries
- Daily and weekly travel caps
- Automatic discounts applied



Contactless Payment

Tap your credit card, debit card, or phone to pay

- Same fares as Opal card
 - No need to buy separate card
- Daily caps still apply



Single Trip Tickets

Paper tickets for one-off journeys

- More expensive than Opal
- Available at stations
- No transfer discounts



Buses

Extensive bus network operated by various companies covering all of Greater Sydney.

- Most routes: 5:00 AM - 11:00 PM
- NightRide services: 11:00 PM - 5:00 AM
- Metrobus services for faster journeys
- Tap on and off with Opal card

Pro Tip: Take Bus 333 from Circular Quay to Bondi Beach for iconic coastal views!



INSIDER TIPS

- Avoid peak hours (7-9 AM, 5-7 PM) on major lines
- Take the Manly ferry for the best harbour experience
- Sunday funday fare cap makes exploring beaches affordable
- Opal cards work on all transport - no need for multiple tickets
- Download TripView before you arrive - locals swear by it
